Camp Dates: July 8-12, 2024 at Grinnell College in Grinnell, Iowa.

Cost: \$380, \$80 deposit due at registration, balance due by June 15, 2024.

Camp Check-In Details

Monday, July 8, 2024 during your assigned arrival time (will be during 8 —10:30 AM)

Address: Osgood Natatorium at Grinnell College's Bear Athletic Center 1201 10th Avenue, Grinnell, Iowa.

- Park in Lot directly across from Bear Athletic Center at 1201 10th Ave, Grinnell, IA
- **Leave luggage in vehicle** (you can drop off at the assigned dorm after check-in)
- Bring completed & signed Camper Health Form & Med Admin form (if applicable)
- Bring all medication in original containers in a Ziploc bag labeled with camper's full name
- Spending money for camp "bank"

Camp Check-Out Details

Friday, July 10, 2024 at 12 PM.

Address: 1201 10th Ave, Grinnell, IA in Bear Athletic Center.

- Prior to dismissal campers will need to clean their dorm room, take out their trash and have room
 inspected by camp staff. Campers must return their key or pay for key replacement prior to
 departure.
- Park in lot directly across from Bear Athletic Center
- Campers will be dismissed from the Bear Athletic Center to the green space between the Natatorium and Athletic Center

Dorm Rooms & Keys

Each camper will be issued ONE key to their dorm room. Dorm keys are the responsibility of their camper. Lost keys require a \$75 replacement fee prior to departure from camp.
